### **Fallsburg**

- The median household income in Fallsburg is \$38,200, only 70% of the New York State median household income of \$54,659.
- The unemployment rate in Fallsburg and all of Sullivan County is 9.7%, a full point higher than the national average.
- The Fallsburg community is 68% Caucasian, 15% African American, 14% Hispanic, 1% Asian and 2% multiracial. At last census, 10% of Fallsburg's population is foreign-born, and English-as-a-Second-Language students are a growing population in the Fallsburg Schools.
- In the Fallsburg School District, 68% of students receive free or reduced lunch pricing. That means that 945 of the 1389 students live at or below 180% of the National Poverty level of \$22,350 for a family of four.
- Of our club kids, 36% live with two parents and 64% live in single parent households.

#### Performance Metrics 2011 - 2012

- All age-appropriate afterschool locations will promote and support a Torch and/or Keystone Club with officers, regular meetings and minutes and a monthly service project.
- All locations, before- and afterschool, will be responsible for hitting each of the 5 Core Areas of Development no less than 1X per week.
- All locations will have no less than 75% of members participate in Power Hour or HYLAs at least 3X per week.
- All locations will have no less than 75% of members participate in physical or recreation activities at least 3X per week.
- All age-appropriate locations will have 75% of members participate in a service project or service "moment" at least 1X per month.
- All locations will have at least 2 presentations or outside speakers per month. These topics and speakers are to be "driven" through youth choice.

Organization-wide, we are tracking on-time grade progression, diminished juvenile justice contact and the 40 Development Assets for youth through preand post-testing, school and law enforcement records and self-reporting.

## Community Snapshots: October 2011

#### Monticello

- The median household income in Monticello is \$29,880, only 45% of the New York State median household income of \$54,659.
- The unemployment rate in Monticello and all of Sullivan County is 9.7%, a full point higher than the national average.
- The Monticello community is 27% Caucasian, 34% African American, 33% Hispanic, 4% Asian and 2% multiracial. More than 14% of Monticello's documented population is foreign-born.
- In the Monticello School District, 51% of students receive free or reduced lunch pricing. That means that 1646 of the 3448 students live at or below 180% of the National Poverty level of \$22,350 for a family of four.
- Of our club kids, 43% live with two parents, 56% live in a single parent household and 1% live with grandparents, guardians or in foster care.

### **Liberty**

- The median household income in Liberty is \$29,880, only 45% of the New York State median household income of \$54,659.
- The unemployment rate in Liberty and all of Sullivan County is 9.7%, a full point higher than the national average.
- The Liberty community is 65% Caucasian, 6% African American, 15% Hispanic, 3% Asian and 7% multiracial. The Hispanic population has grown considerably in Liberty over the past ten years and local elected officials have attributed this spike to an increase in jobs at two food processing facilities. Currently 10% of Liberty's population is foreignborn.
- In the Liberty School District, 68% of students receive free or reduced lunch pricing. That means that 1105 of the 1625 students live at or below 180% of the National Poverty level of \$22,350 for a family of four.
- Of our club kids, 62% live with two parents, 32% live in a single parent household and 6% live with grandparents, guardians or in foster care.
