WHEREAS, the Sullivan County Division of Planning & Environmental Management ("Division") oversees the County Main Street and Agri-Business Revolving Loan Funds funded through grants received from the New York Governor's Office of Small Cities; and

WHEREAS, the Division has submitted the loan report to the Sullivan County Revolving Loan Fund Advisory Board; and

RESOLUTION NO. INTRODUCED BY PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE TO APPROVE AMENDMENTS TO THREE POLICIES & PROCEDURES OF THE SULLIVAN COUNTY BUREAU OF FIRE AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

- WHEREAS, Richard Martinkovic, Sullivan County Fire Coordinator, annually reviews Bureau of Fire policies and procedures that require amendment, and
- **WHEREAS**, at its regular monthly meeting on March 28, 2012, the Fire Advisory Board approved amendments to the following:

Fire Investigation Team Policy, Responsibilities and Qualifications; Sullivan County Emergency Services Photo ID Policy and Accountability Tag Use;

Sullivan County Emergency Services Training Center Class Registration Policy

- WHEREAS, the amendments to the above policies shall take effect upon approval of same by the Public Safety Committee and Sullivan County Legislature.
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Sullivan County Bureau of Fire policies and procedures listed above are hereby approved, and
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that copies, as amended, shall be filed with the Clerk of the Sullivan County Legislature and County Manager.



RESOLUTION NO. INTRODUCED BY THE MANAGEMENT & BUDGET COMMITTEE TO EXECUTE ANY AND ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS, ACCEPT THE AWARD, AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH NEW YORK STATE OFFICE OF INDIGENT LEGAL SERVICES AND MODIFICATION AGREEMENTS WITH SULLIVAN LEGAL AID PANEL, INC. AND SULLIVAN COUNTY CONFLICT LEGAL AID SOCIETY

WHEREAS, New York State Office of Indigent Legal Services ("NYSOILS") has offered the County of Sullivan ("County") funding through an Upstate Quality Improvement and Caseload Reduction grant in the amount of \$299,526 over a three (3) year period in order to improve the quality of indigent legal services provided by the County pursuant to Article 18-b of the County Law; and

WHEREAS, in order to acquire the funding the County must submit the necessary documents to NYSOILS, accept the award, and enter into an agreement with NYSOILS to administer the funding; and

WHEREAS, in order to provide the additional funding to the Legal Aid Panel and Conflict Legal Aid it will be necessary to modify their respective contracts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Sullivan County Legislature hereby authorizes the County Manager to execute any and all necessary documents to submit to NYSOILS to receive the funding for 2014-2016; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Manager is hereby authorized to execute an agreement for a 3 year period, 2014-2016 for a total amount of \$299,526 to acquire the funding from NYSOILS, said documents to be in a form approved by the County Attorney; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Manager is hereby authorized to executive Modification Agreements with Legal Aid Panel for an amount not to exceed \$62,000 per year for a 3 year period, and Conflict Legal Aid for an amount not to exceed \$37,842 per year for a 3 year period and/or any other appropriate entity that contracts with the County of Sullivan for Indigent Legal services under Article 18-b of the County Law as outlined above, said Modification Agreements to be in a form approved by the County Attorney's Office.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that should the NYSOILS funding be terminated, the County shall not be obligated to continue any action undertaken by the use of this funding.

WHEREAS, the County of Sullivan is mandated to provide professional services for the inmate population at the Sullivan County Jail, and

WHEREAS, a proposal was received for inmate dental services for the Sullivan County Jail, and

WHEREAS, Dentrust Dental New York, P.C. a corporation of the State of New York with offices located at 6097 Easton Road, Pipersville, Pennsylvania 18947 (hereinafter, "Dentrust") is the lowest responsible contractor for such work, and

WHEREAS, the Sullivan County Jail Administrator approved said proposal and recommends that a contract be executed, and

WHEREAS, Dentrust has agreed to provide dental services for the Sullivan County Jail pursuant to the attached Fee Schedule for a one year term effective May 1, 2016 and may be renewed by mutual consent of both parties for four additional one-year terms.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the County Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Dentrust as per the attached Fee Schedule, and in accordance with RFP, R-16-08, and said contract shall be in a form approved by the County Attorney's Office.
