RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE TO AUTHORIZE THE COUNTY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A POWER PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH SOLARCITY CORPORATION

WHEREAS, NYSERDA has announced the award of funding to SolarCity Corporation ("SolarCity") for the development of a 2,405.40 kW solar photovoltaic system ("the project") at the site of the Sullivan County Adult Care Center through the NY-SUN Competitive Program, and

WHEREAS, Sullivan County ("the County") previously submitted a non-binding letter of intent to NYSERDA indicating mutual intent between SolarCity and the County to develop the project, and

WHEREAS, the project will be designed, installed, and maintained at no cost to the County and would provide a reduced cost of electricity during the project's 20 year life, and

WHEREAS, the County wishes to pursue this partnership and seeks to enter into a Power Purchase Agreement with Solar City for the purchase of electricity to be utilized at the Sullivan County Adult Care Center.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the County Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a Power Purchase Agreement with SolarCity Corporation for the project, said agreement to be in a form approved by the County Attorney's Office.
