RESOLUTION NO. INTRODUCED BY GOVERNMENT SERVICES COMMITTEE TO ASK FOR AN INCREASE OF STATE SUPPORT FOR CORNELL COOPERATIVE EXTENSION COUNTY ASSOCIATIONS IN THE STATE OF NEW YORK

WHEREAS, Cornell Cooperative Extension is a formal collaboration between the National Institute of Food and Agriculture at USDA, New York State, County Governments and the Citizens of the State that has served to apply unbiased, research-based knowledge from Cornell, New York's Land Grant University, to the needs of New Yorkers and their communities for over 100 years; and

WHEREAS, local extension educators are key community partners in helping to implement state initiatives including maximizing agriculture and local food systems, strengthening the economy, promoting healthier eating habits and access to good nutrition, fighting poverty particularly in rural areas, protecting water quality and stewardship of the York's natural resources, building opportunity through STEM based youth education and leadership skills in 4-H, promoting renewable energy options while protecting farmland resources, and partnering where appropriate in Taste NY initiatives to promote tourism and local food and farm businesses, and

WHEREAS, support from Federal, State and County sources is essential to the continued success of locally-governed county cooperative extension associations; and

WHEREAS, state appropriations for county cooperative extension associations to match county government appropriations as authorized by Section 224 (8) of the County Law have remained stagnant for seventeen years; and

WHEREAS, state funding is needed to ensure that the Cornell Cooperative Extension system can equitably work for all New York residents through increased resources to support rural, suburban, and urban community development needs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Sullivan County Legislature hereby supports increasing the State appropriation for Cornell Cooperative Extension associations to \$8 million, such funds to be distributed directly to the associations through Cornell University as agent for the state, as provided by law.

RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY GOVERNMENT SERVICES COMMITTEE TO RESCIND RESOLUTION NO. 392-17 AND TO AUTHORIZE AWARD AND EXECUTION OF CONTRACT FOR ADDITIONAL TRANSPORTATION SERVICES

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 392-17 was adopted by the Sullivan County Legislature on September 19, 2017 to enter into a contract with Rolling V Bus Corporation, P.O. Box 110, Route 42, South Fallsburg, New York 12779 ("Rolling V"), and

WHEREAS, the content in Resolution No. 392-17 was incorrect in its entirety, and

WHEREAS, bids were received for Fall and Summer Early Intervention Transportation Services – Part B – Additional Routes, and

WHEREAS, Rolling V was the lowest responsible bidder for such work, and will provide said services at the following rates:

Route #9 – Field of Dreams III

= \$465.00/Vehicle/Day

Route #10 – Learning Together Inc.

= \$465.00/Vehicle/Day

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Legislature hereby rescinds Resolution No. 392-17 in its entirety, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Manager be and hereby is authorized to execute an agreement with Rolling V Bus Corporation for the above services and at the above rates, in accordance with Bid No. B-17-42, for the period September 5, 2017 through December 31, 2021, with an option to extend for an additional five (5) year period, and

WHEREAS, Sullivan County is seeking to increase competitive bidding practice to minimize costs and time delays associated with purchasing procurement process, and

WHEREAS, BidNet, a regional purchasing group, is a single, online location for local governments to post, distribute and manage Bids, RFPs, quotes, addendums and awards online. Vendors will benefit by only having to register once to see all local bid opportunities. BidNet provides notification to registered vendors of new relevant solicitations, any addenda and award information, and

WHEREAS, the Sullivan County Purchasing and Central Services Department has decided to proceed with joining International Data Base Corporation, doing business under the trade name BidNet, a legally incorporated body having its principal place of business at 15 British American Boulevard, Latham, New York, 12110 for the solicitation/issuance of Bids and Request for Proposals, and

WHEREAS, Purchasing and Central Services Department approves and recommends that an agreement be executed.
