Order of Business:

RESOLUTION NO. 408-16_ INTRODUCED BY LUIS ALVAREZ, CHAIRMAN OF THE SULLIVAN COUNTY LEGISLATURE AND DISTRICT 6 LEGISLATOR, TO DOCUMENT THE LEGISLATURE'S DETERMINATION TO INCLUDE THE SHERIFF'S ADMINISTRATION/ROAD PATROL BUILDING IN THE BASIS OF AWARD FOR THE COUNTY JAIL PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the County of Sullivan ("County") owns of approximately fifty acres of vacant land on which it intends to build a new County Jail and possible related facilities ("County Jail Project"); and

WHEREAS, at the time the invitation to bid was prepared, due to cost concerns, the County Legislature was not certain whether a new Sheriff's Administration/Road Patrol building should also be built; and

WHEREAS, due to the aforementioned concern, a new Sheriff's Administration/Road Patrol building was included in the County's invitation to bid as "Alternate No. 1: Construction of Sheriff's Administration and Road Patrol"; and

WHEREAS, the County's bid opening occurred on October 5, 2016 and based on the bids submitted for both the new County Jail and Bid Alternate No. 1: Construction of Sheriff's Administration and Road Patrol, it is in the best interest of the County to authorize an analysis of the new County Jail and Sheriff's Administration/Road Patrol building together as the basis of award for the County Jail Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the County Legislature hereby determines to include the Sheriff's Administration/Road Patrol building with the County Jail building, and all associated costs, as the basis of a bid award; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this determination is solely to permit County staff and consulting team to analyze the bids submitted and qualification of bidders in an effort to determine the lowest responsible bidder; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Legislature understands that this Resolution neither constitutes a recommendation of a particular vendor nor an award of a County project, both of which shall occur at a later date.
