#### Procedure:

- 1. Verify provider's order.
- 2. Explain the purpose and procedure to the patient. The purpose is to promote non-invasive patent urinary flow.
- 3. Perform hand hygiene
- 4. Don non-sterile gloves
- 5. Instruct or assist patient to wash genitalia with soap and water. Rinse well. Dry.
- 6. Assess shaft of penis and scrotum for irritation, swelling, or excretions.
- 7. Roll condom catheter over the penis, leaving approximately on inch between the end of the penis and the catheter.
- 8. Assess for a snug but not tight fit.
- 9. Secure condom catheter according to manufacturer's guidelines.
- 10. Connect the adapter to tubing/ bag.
- 11. Instruct patient/ caregiver to:
  - a. Empty bag
  - b. Switch leg and night bags
  - c. Remove condom catheter daily to clean penis
  - d. Assess penis frequently for swelling or discoloration
  - e. Remove condom catheter for swelling, discoloration or pain.
- 12. Remove gloves and perform hand hygiene.
- 13. Document procedure, including the following in the patient's clinical record:
  - a. Condition of the penis

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- b. Reaction of the patient
- c. Color and amount of urine
- d. Instructions/ teaching provided to patient/ caregiver.
