**Procedure:**

1. HHAs are expected to adhere to uniform attire.
2. The uniform consists of
  - a. Blouse/shirt- white- may have coordinating khaki trim on a solid background, no patterns.
  - b. Dress, skirt or skort (no more than 3” above the knee), or slacks- khaki- must be solid color
  - c. Jacket, blazer or sweater- khaki or white- must be solid color
3. Clothing is to be clean, pressed and stain-free.
4. Footwear is to be close toed. All footwear must be clean and in good condition.
5. Unacceptable attire:
  - a. Denim, sandals, fleece, sweatshirt, halter tops, leggings.
6. HHAs will wear a picture ID that is proper and current. This will include name, title, photograph and agency name.
