RESOLUTION INTRODUCED BY EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE TO ABOLISH CERTAIN POSITIONS AND REDUCE APPROPRIATIONS IN RESPONSE TO THE ECONOMIC DISRUPTION RESULTING FROM THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC AND POTENTIAL STATE AID CUTS AS A RESULT OF THE RECENTLY ADOPTED NEW YORK STATE 2020-2021 BUDGET

**WHEREAS**, the County of Sullivan, like most other New York State counties will be facing unprecedented fiscal challenges as a result of the economic disruption resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic and expected State Aid reductions a result of the recently adopted New York State 2020-2021 budget, and

WHEREAS, the County of Sullivan projects significant declines in available revenues from sales tax due to New York State mandating all non-essential businesses be closed and declines in state aid, due to projected losses in state revenue of upwards of fifteen billion dollars, and

**WHEREAS**, the County of Sullivan projects significant increases in required expenditures responding to the COVID-19 pandemic, costs associated with numerous social services programs due to the unprecedented number of unemployed people, and substantially higher pension contribution rates due to substantial reductions in value in the stock market, and

WHEREAS, the County Manager has recommended that the County Legislature take immediate action to mitigate the effects of certain revenue declines and expense increases associated with the COVID-19 pandemic.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Sullivan County Legislature hereby abolishes certain vacant positions, reduces certain equipment purchases, and reduces certain contractual appropriations as detailed in Schedule A, and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that the Sullivan County Legislature hereby abolishes filled positions in Schedule B effective May 2, 2020, and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that the County will continue to pay its currently obligated share of insurance for each employee in Schedule B with the employee continuing to pay their share of insurance until such time that the Legislature rescinds this authorization, and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that the County will allow employees laid-off to maintain their accrual balances including vacation, sick, and comp time until such time that the Legislature rescinds this authorization which would result in the County paying out the vacation and comp-time accruals, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, for employees laid-off on Schedule B and who return to employment with the County, the County will consider the employee as having been

continuously employed for clauses in collective bargaining agreements and the Personnel Policies for Non-Union Employees which require continuous employment, and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that the Sullivan County Legislature authorizes the County Manager to make the appropriate budget modification to effectuate the changes in Schedule A and B.
