

-38 MORE THAN 2023 -APPLICATIONS WERE ACCEPTED APRIL 1 - MAY 31, 2024






-INCOME ELIGIBILITY IS BASED ON 200% OF FEDERAL POVERTY GUIDELINES

HIRED AGE & PRIOR EMPLOYMENT

-THIS WAS A FIRST EMPLOYMENT EXPERIENCE FOR APPROXIMATELY 72% OF HIRED PARTICIPANTS

-YOUTH WERE PLACED IN THEIR SITES BASED ON THEIR INTERVIEW, AREAS OF INTEREST & EASE OF ACCESSIBILITY







-ALL HIRED YOUTH ATTENDED A MANDATORY ORIENTATION ON JULY 8, 2024 IN THE LEGISLATIVE HEARING ROOM

-CURRENT COUNTY POLICIES & THE PARTICIPANT HANDBOOK WERE REVIEWED TO INCLUDE SEXUAL HARASSMENT TRAINING

-AN ICEBREAKER ACTIVITY WAS DONE OUTSIDE "TO HAVE OR HAVE KNOT"









GEOGRAPHIC INFORMATION OF HIRED YOUTH

-3 CREW LEADERS WERE HIRED
























LEARN & EARN





SELF REPORTED DIVERSITY
