The Peer Advocates primary responsibility is visiting clients in the community and on-site to provide support and overdose prevention training and offer ongoing support and referral to care for clients and their families, by using first-hand lived experience using substances to provide support through risk reduction counseling, naloxone training, and linkage to care.

Hours and salary: This is a full-time position. \$18.00 - \$20.00 hourly, plus generous, full benefits; Health Insurance, Dental Insurance, Paid Vacation, Paid Sick Leave, Holidays, and 401K/Retirement. Some of the essential duties of position:

- 1. Using lived experience with substance use to support clients, introduce the program to potential clients and obtain consents for follow up services.
- 2. Conduct overdose prevention education with clients, their families and their social networks including naloxone distribution.
- 3. Assist clients with linkage to care and community resources.

- 4. Provide/offer information on referral options to harm reduction programs, medication assisted treatment, and other services.
- 5. Coordinate and monitor the implementation of the program requirement and referrals to community services.
- 6. Technical assistance and provide training on program implementation, policies and procedures as needed.
- 7. Builds relationships and collaborates with community partners on continued integration of the SOR Program.
- 8. Maintain detailed records of client contacts and follow-up activities. Collect and report program data to evaluate program performance as required.
- 9. Facilitate groups using evidence-based models (i.e. Seeking Safety, Holistic Health Recovery Program). Catholic Charities of Orange, Sullivan & Ulster is an equal opportunity employer.
