Habitat – Chairman Fred Bosch thanked all the Federation members who helped inspecting the projects. Clubs were awarded a total of \$5975 this year, a substantial increase from last year.

Sportsmen's Education – Chairman Carl Lindsley stated there are no courses in Sullivan County. Call the DEC at 845-256-3122 for nearest courses. Ulster Heights Rod & Gun Club has a trapping course 10/15. Ulster Rod & Gun has a gun course 10/22, bow course 10/23 & another gun course 11/5.

NRA/PRO HUNTING – Chairman Bob Morgan reported on gun control actions. Pink is the new hot clothing color for hunting and youths 14-15 year olds have to wear pink or orange this year, at least 250 square inches.

SWEEPSTAKES – Chairman Hank Samyn reported that the Federation made a profit of \$10,074.59 this year. The increase from previous years was because we did not have to buy an ATV this year. Last year the winner took the consolation prize of \$3,000 cash.
